### Classic Wilderness Camp

Ongava Game Reserve, originally four cattle ranches, now abounds with game and serves as a vital buffer zone between Etosha National Park and farming communities further south. In this reserve, the well-established Ongava Lodge offers luxury accommodation in twelve thatched en-suite chalets. There are impressive views from the main lounge, pub and dining areas, as they are situated close to the top of the foothills of the Ondundozonanandana Range.



Guests can track rhino on foot or go on a game drive to view elephant, lion, black rhino, springbok, gemsbok and hartebeest. Leopard and cheetah also occur in this area. Birdlife is outstanding with White-tailed Shrike, Short-toed Rock Thrush, Hartlaub's Francolin and raptors in abundance. Consider enhancing your Etosha journey with a private guide and game drive vehicle, both of which can be arranged with adequate advance notice.

Little Ongava is perched on the crest of a hill in the private 30 000-hectare Ongava Game Reserve commanding magnificent vistas of the African plains beyond. Arguably Namibia's most civilised and certainly most comfortable accommodation, exclusive without being indulgent, Little Ongava offers an extraordinary experience from which to focus your Etosha journey. Anticipate a warm welcome at this intimate and exclusive lodge, with only three spacious, private and luxurious suites each with its own plunge pool, en-suite bathroom, a 'sala', and outdoor 'al fresco' shower.



The dining and lounge area has a wonderful view of the waterhole below the camp and lends itself to relaxed, stylish dining under an African sky or under thatch. Day and night wildlife-viewing drives, visiting hides that overlook waterholes and walks with experienced guides can all be enjoyed exclusively on this reserve. Such game drives and daytrips into the easily accessible Etosha National Park are rewarding, with sightings of lion, elephant, gemsbok, springbok, hartebeest, and white and black rhino. Guests at Little Ongava share a dedicated guide and Land Rover, ensuring the best possible nature experience at one of Africa's great wildlife destinations.

### Vintage Wilderness Camp

Ongava Tented Camp is Etosha's best kept secret, tucked into a hidden valley at the foot of an anonymous hill in the privately owned 30 000-ha Ongava Game Reserve bordering the Etosha National Park. Activities at this comfortable camp typically begin in the main area with its tranquil bar and swimming pool fronting onto a much-frequented waterhole. The camp accommodates up to 18 exclusive guests in nine large Meru tents, all with en-suite facilities, open air showers and private verandas. The family unit sleeps four.



This complete Etosha experience in private luxury offers activities such as guided walks, bird watching, hides, night drives, great company and great food. A special encounter is white rhino tracking – Ongava holds one of the largest rhino custodianships for the Namibian government; these have been set up in safe havens throughout the country in the hopes of breeding rhino up to more sustainable numbers and reintroducing them into areas where they previously flourished.
